Corporate Social Responsibility

Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) has been an inherited & inbuilt element of our fundamentals, right from the day the Bank was founded. Our Founder's values & ethos based on trust got embedded in the Bank's policies & principles. For us at Federal Bank, reaching out to people who need assistance is part of the values passed by our founder. The Corporate Social Responsibility activities of the Bank touch a wide footprint through areas like Health, Education, Women empowerment, Environment sustainability and other activities permitted by the Schedule VII of the Companies Act, 2013.

CSR projects of the Bank are executed under the aegis of Federal Bank Hormis Memorial Foundation, the special purpose vehicle constituted for the implementation of CSR activities of the Bank.

Objectives:

- To make meaningful contributions for the improvement of the financially disadvantaged sections of our society, and thereby act as socially conscious, well governed, and successful corporate citizens of the country.
- To ensure that the activities undertaken will bring maximum relief to the intended beneficiaries and thereby contribute to the long-term development of society, by providing socially and environmentally sustainable benefits, measurable in economic terms, demonstrating the social commitment of the Bank in the same manner it services the customers, employees, and shareholders.

Major projects carried out during the period-01.04.2023 to 31.03.2024

1. Promoting Education - Federal Bank Hormis Memorial Foundation Scholarships

The Foundation has been providing scholarships to needy students for pursuing professional courses for many years. Every year the Trust is offering scholarships to a maximum of 500 meritorious students pursuing the courses- BSc Agriculture, B Sc Nursing, BE/B Tech, MBBS & MBA-belonging to the states-Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Karnataka, Maharashtra, Gujarat & Punjab. In FY 2023-24, we received 4,060 applications online and 476 students were selected for the scholarship.

2. Livelihood Enhancement Projects - Skill Development - Federal Skill Academies

While India has the largest percentage of youth population in the world, it has a very high percentage of unskilled youth as well. Recognizing that gaps exist between the knowledge imparted through formal education and the skills that are required at the workplace, the Bank has set up Federal Skill Academy as part of its thrust for social upliftment and eventually to be part of the National Skill Development Mission.

As part of its Corporate Social Responsibility initiatives, the Bank started its first Federal Skill Academy at Kochi on Founder's Day 2015 to impart quality technical education to meritorious students coming from economically underprivileged backgrounds. The objective is to empower the youth, to mentor and assist them to upgrade their skills for improved employability, increased efficiency, and career growth.

Federal Skill Academy currently operates in 7 centers across India (at Kochi, Coimbatore, Kolhapur, Faridabad, Belgaum, Ambattur & Vijayawada) with a total of 14 courses being offered. A total of 5460+ trainees have been skilled and certified so far with a placement percentage of 85%.

3. Sanjeevani – United Against Cancer

Following the success of 'Sanjeevani – A Shot Of Life', to boost COVID-19 vaccine awareness in 2021, News18 and Federal Bank Hormis Memorial Foundation partnered again to uplift societal health through its reach across the country. Federal Bank joined hands with TV 18, Assam Cancer Care Foundation & Tata Cancer Care Foundation to create awareness and break the chains of stigma & fear surrounding cancer which claims a lot of lives every year. The Bank also provides support for treatment to patients in association with Assam Cancer Care Foundation & Tata Cancer Care Foundation.

The project also aims to offer support to socio-economically disadvantaged individuals seeking assistance at Assam Cancer Care Hospitals and Sri Venkateswara Institute of Cancer Care & Advanced Research (SVICCAR), Tirupati, for early detection and cancer diagnosis. This aid includes financial assistance for diagnostic tests and/or cancer treatment for the residents of Assam, Andhra Pradesh and the surrounding states. This initiative has supported 3,168 beneficiaries, with more than 17,000 services being provided.

4. Speak For India 2023-24 Edition

Speak for India is an initiative to encourage young, dynamic, and enthusiastic minds across the nation to raise their voice on pertinent issues and play the role of change-makers in society. The event offers collegegoing students a podium to explore their awareness, insights, and perspective on contemporary topics.

Speak for India was first launched in 2014-15 in Kerala under the auspices of Federal Bank Hormis Memorial Foundation. In FY24, Speak for India was conducted in 7 states across the country. The Kerala Edition was conducted in association with Mathrubhumi. Editions in Tamil Nadu, Karnataka, Maharashtra, Delhi NCR were conducted in association with Times of India. The West Bengal Edition was in association with ABP and Gujarat Edition in association with DB Corp. Speak for India 2023-24 saw the participation of 27,420 students from more than 5,000 colleges across India.

5. Clean Mookkannoor Project

Federal Bank spearheaded the 'Mookkannoor Mission', an initiative under the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan. The event was inaugurated by Shri. Shyam Srinivasan, MD & CEO on 18th of October 2023, at the 106th birth anniversary of Founder Late K P Hormis. Mookkannoor is a village in Ernakulam district, Kerala, the birthplace of the Bank's Founder. Activities proposed under the Mookkannoor Mission include Waste Management, Tree Plantation, Community Development activities, Renewable energy projects, Promoting Sports, Women Empowerment etc. The aim of the project is to transform the village into one of the cleanest cities in India.

The Bank completed distribution of bio bins to 4569 households and aims to distribute 2000 Grow Bags in 14 wards of Mookkannoor Panchayath. On International Women's Day 2024, the Bank initiated an event to spread awareness among the women in the panchayath by distributing 243 menstrual cups. An electric auto was sponsored for waste collection in the panchayath.
