To diminish reliance on traditional power sources and to lower the cost associated with it, Federal Bank has partially sponsored for the installation of a solar power plant of 50 Kw capacity at the college.

The St. Joseph's Higher Secondary School, Mathilakam has around 1,600 students, mostly from economically weaker sections of the society, and the school provides mid-day meals for these children. In order to modernize their kitchen facilities, we have facilitated provision of a rice boiler of 50 kg capacity and a rice washing machine of 30 kg capacity. This will help in meeting the requirements of the school to cater to such all students. The school is the biggest in Thrissur, Kerala in terms of the number of



children studying and is well-known for its academic and non-academic activities as well as providing good education to the children with modern facilities in all aspects.

Muthalamada is a rural area located in Kollengode block of Palakkad district, Kerala. The Government Higher Secondary School consists of grades from 5 – 12. In order to enhance the educational infrastructure at the school, Federal bank provided 10 whiteboards which is now installed in 10 classrooms of the school.

Education is a basic human right for all children regardless of their social status or their disabilities and we at Federal Bank are strong believers of this. A school bus was donated to Navshakti Vidyalaya in Rajkot which is a school for children with special needs. There are about 90 students studying in this school from economically backward families who do not have the means to provide good education to their children. The school was established in the year 1993 and is run by The Diocese of Rajkot which undertakes various educational, health care and social work activities for the betterment of the people from different strata of the society.

The temple, however, is situated in a hilly region, making it difficult for the aged and the differently abled to access the temple.

To solve this issue, Federal Bank has donated an 8-seater buggy, which will help the aged and the differently abled navigate the hilly terrain.
