Federal Bank Hormis Memorial Foundation, instituted as a public charitable trust in 1996, to perpetuate the fond memory of the Bank's founder late K. P. Hormis, is the principal arm in implementing various CSR programs/ projects of the Bank. The activities of the Trust are directed towards inculcating better knowledge and awareness in the field of banking through training programmes, focused seminars, and so on.

Federal Bank has been meaningfully contributing for the improvement of society to create a positive impact on the world through its sustainable practices, philanthropic endeavours, and community engagement. The Bank has approved a policy for Sustainable Development, which ensures that Bank's activities are conducive to sustainable social welfare. Gram Panchayat Mianpur Changar, Punjab – Establishment of Open Gym Facility



Federal Bank supported Gram Panchayat Mianpur Changar to establish an open gym facility in the local park. This facility, accessible 24/7, provides free fitness resources to children, youth, and the elderly, fostering a culture of physical activity and overall well-being in the community.

This Sensory Park will offer a safe, therapeutic space designed to enhance sensory, cognitive, and motor skills, particularly for children with disabilities, fostering their physical and social development. Many students from economically challenged backgrounds will greatly benefit from this inclusive facility.

As part of Federal Bank's commitment to healthcare, we have donated an Aquatic Treadmill to Peace Valley, a charitable trust supporting palliative care and paraplegic rehabilitation since 2014. This facility will aid in the rehabilitation of 144 patients monthly, offering benefits like pain relief, improved mobility, and faster recovery. The initiative underscores the commitment to empowering marginalized communities with advanced therapeutic solutions.
